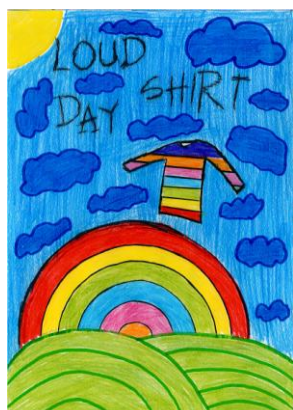


Colour Me LOUD
